Outline of the AuthorAID Online Course in Research Writing

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Introduction

This free online course is offered regularly to researchers in developing countries. The course is spread over 5 weeks and taught on <u>INASP Moodle</u>. At least one facilitator is present in the course, who takes responsibility for answering learners' questions on the discussion forum, supporting learners facing difficulties, and evaluating learners' work.

Learners are selected for each course following a competitive application process. Calls for applications are announced on the <u>AuthorAID blog</u>. Learners are asked to devote at least 3 to 4 hours per week on the course. Course completion certificates are issued by AuthorAID to learners who complete the lessons and activities.
